B. REQUEST FOR QUOTATION FOR SANSA NEWSLETTERS

The South African National Space Agency (SANSA) requires a service provider to develop and distribute 4 x issues of a digital SANSA wide newsletters.

1. BACKGROUND TO SANSA

The South African National Space Agency (SANSA) has a mandate, as outlined in the South African National Space Agency Act, 2008 (Act No 36 of 2008), to co-ordinate and integrate national space science and technology programmes and conduct long-term planning and implementation of space-related activities in South Africa, for the benefit of the citizens of South Africa

2. SCOPE OF WORK (TERMS OF REFERENCE)

SANSA requires four SANSA wide digital newsletters, to be developed and distributed quarterly (+- 3500 email addresses)

This should include design, research, interviews, writing, editing and layout of 4 x issues of the digital newsletter.

SANSA wide newsletters should include the below:

- This newsletter should cover all aspects of SANSA and is therefore referred to as "SANSA wide".
- ❖ 12 x full length stories +- 400 words to be re-written/developed/edited per quarterly newsletter.
- Sourcing of free imagery when there is no suitable imagery available from SANSA.
- Events/opportunities calendar of local and international space related events/bursary calls etc.
- ❖ A "What's happening in Space" section highlighting interesting space related and relevant content from industry sources (will be directed by SANSA).
- Provide template for the design and layout of the newsletter.
- Design and content to be approved by SANSA before publishing.
- ❖ Distribution of the newsletter using Mailchimp to SANSA stakeholder list. All setup and distribution costs to be included in quote. The service provider will be responsible for purchasing Mailchimp distribution packages/email credits for each newsletter edition.

- Provide Mailchimp analytical report for each newsletter published.
- The newsletter and each individual story should have sharing buttons to social media platforms such as Facebook, Twitter and Whatsapp etc.
- ❖ All newsletter content to be uploaded and shared on the SANSA website.
- ❖ Development and distribution should take 2-3 weeks per newsletter issue.

Please note:

- Service provider to test and ensure each newsletter's compatibility with all major email platforms (Outlook, Gmail etc.) and web browsers (Chrome, Firefox, Safari etc.).
- All content to be approved by SANSA before publishing.
- ❖ The actual number of SANSA wide issues will depend on the budget available in the financial year.

C. EVALUATION CRITERIA

SANSA promotes the concept of "best value" in the award of contracts, as opposed to merely looking for the cheapest price, which does not necessarily provide the best value. Best value incorporates the expertise, experience and technical proposal of the organisation and individuals who will be providing the service and the organisational capacity supporting the project team.

SANSA is committed to achieving Government's transformation objectives in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act.

The value of this bid is estimated not to exceed R1 million (all applicable taxes included) and therefore the **80/20** system shall be applicable.

The procedure for the evaluation of responsive tenders is **Price** and **Preference** method.

Bids will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference points systems, where the 80 points will be used for price only and the 20 points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contributor in accordance with the Table below
