B. REQUEST FOR QUOTATION FOR

1. BACKGROUND TO SANSA

The South African National Space Agency (SANSA) has a mandate, as outlined in the South African National Space Agency Act, 2008 (Act No 36 of 2008), to co-ordinate and integrate national space science and technology programmes and conduct long-term planning and implementation of space-related activities in South Africa, for the benefit of the citizens of South Africa

2. SCOPE OF WORK (TERMS OF REFERENCE)

SANSA Hermanus is hosting the ICAO Workshop/Conference at its Space Weather Centre from Monday 5 to Wednesday 7 June 2023.

We are expecting up to 40 pax to attend the three-day conference and will require the following services:

- Caterina
- Bottled still water 2 per day for each delegate

Catering:

- Tea & coffee station will be required daily
- Tea & coffee and assorted muffins to be served on arrival on all three days
- Mid-morning tea and coffee with biscuits and savoury snack on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday
- Afternoon tea with biscuits for Monday and Tuesday only
- Lunch: assorted substantial canapes will be required for each day Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday with a different menu selection per day. Vegan, vegetarian and gluten-free options to be included.
- Special dietary requirements if requested, will have to be catered for including Halaal and Kosher
- Refreshments for lunch should include Grapetisers, Appletisers and bottled sparkling and still mineral water
- Ideally most of the catering should be prepared off-site but the kitchen in the Space Weather Centre and the Entertainment Area will be available for use by the caterer
- All crockery, cutlery, glasses and blue and white serviettes to be supplied by the caterer

C. EVALUATION CRITERIA

SANSA promotes the concept of "best value" in the award of contracts, as opposed to merely looking for the cheapest price, which does not necessarily provide the best value. Best value incorporates the expertise, experience and technical proposal of the organisation and individuals who will be providing the service and the organisational capacity supporting the project team.

SANSA is committed to achieving Government's transformation objectives in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act.

The value of this bid is estimated not to exceed R1 million (all applicable taxes included) and therefore the **80/20** system shall be applicable.

The procedure for the evaluation of responsive tenders is **Price** and **Preference** method.

Bids will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference points systems, where the 80 points will be used for price only and the 20 points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contributor in accordance with the Table below
