- 3.6 There have been no consultations, communications, agreements or arrangements made by the bidder with any official of the procuring institution in relation to this procurement process prior to and during the bidding process except to provide clarification on the bid submitted where so required by the institution; and the bidder was not involved in the drafting of the specifications or terms of reference for this bid.

B. REQUEST FOR QUOTATION FOR THE PROVISION OF PRINTED CIRCUIT BOARD (PCB) MANUFACTURING SERVICES.

1. BACKGROUND TO SANSA

The South African National Space Agency (SANSA) has a mandate, as outlined in the South African National Space Agency Act, 2008 (Act No 36 of 2008), to co-ordinate and integrate national space science and technology programmes and conduct long-term planning and implementation of space-related activities in South Africa, for the benefit of the citizens of South Africa

2. SCOPE OF WORK (TERMS OF REFERENCE)

The South African National Space Agency (SANSA) requires the services of a Printed Circuit Board (PCB) manufacturer. In order to meet SANSA's requirements, the manufacturer would need to have the necessary infrastructure and equipment in place, as well as the experience and expertise in PCB manufacturing procedures. These services are required for a period of 3 years.

Proposals are hereby invited from suppliers that have a proven track record for the supply of Printed Circuit Board manufacturing services to the South African National Space Agency relating specifically to the supply of the following manufacture processes:

- Manufacturing of PCBs with a local factory in South Africa with a proven track record of manufacturing capabilities.
- Manufacturing of multi-layer (8+) PCBs consisting of high frequency circuit materials such as Mercurywave™ 9350, of at least 6 signal layers.
- Manufacturing of multi-layer (8+) PCBs consisting of low frequency circuit materials such as FR-4, of at least 6 signal layers.
- Impedance control capability of $\pm 10\%$, is required from the supplier.
- ENIG (Electroless Nickel Immersion Gold) plating capabilities is required from the supplier.
- Through-, blind- and buried plated hole capabilities, is required from the supplier.
- Supply of any manufacturing materials required from the above mentioned for manufacture from the supplier.

C. EVALUATION CRITERIA

SANSA promotes the concept of “best value” in the award of contracts, as opposed to merely looking for the cheapest price, which does not necessarily provide the best value. Best value incorporates the expertise, experience and technical proposal of the organisation and individuals who will be providing the service and the organisational capacity supporting the project team.

SANSA is committed to achieving Government's transformation objectives in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act.

The value of this bid is estimated not to exceed R1 million (all applicable taxes included) and therefore the **80/20** system shall be applicable.

Please Note: the above amount (R1 million) is not the budgeted amount for this project, but it is the Treasury threshold for written price quotations.

The procedure for the evaluation of responsive tenders is **Price, Functionality(quality)** and **Preference** method.

Bids will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference points systems, where the 80 points will be used for price only and the 20 points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the specific goals in accordance with the Table below.

1. Preference

Specific goals for this RFP and number of points are indicated as per the table 1 below.

Proof of the specific goals below must be attached and submitted with the bid document in order to qualify for the preference points (specific goals).

Note to tenderers: The tenderer must indicate how they claim points for each preference point system.
