B. EVALUATION CRITERIA

SANSA promotes the concept of "best value" in the award of contracts, as opposed to merely looking for the cheapest price, which does not necessarily provide the best value. Best value incorporates the expertise, experience, and technical proposal of the organization and individuals who will be providing the service and the organizational capacity supporting the project team.

SANSA is committed to achieving Government's transformation objectives in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act.

The value of this bid is estimated to NOT exceed R1 million (all applicable taxes included) and therefore the **80/20** system shall be applicable.

The procedure for the evaluation of responsive tenders is the **Provision of items that comply to specifications, Price, and Preference** method.

Bids will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference points systems, where 80% of points will be determined by price only and 20% of points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the specific goals in accordance with the Table below.

1. Provision of items

The Bidder shall provide ALL items that comply with the stated specification or similar, standard and/or part number as well as their respective quantities as indicated in the Table 1 above.

Note: Consumables and spares stated in Table 1 need to be compatible with the respective equipment i.e. line items 1, 3, 5 and 7 (Brush Cutter, Chainsaw, Lawn mower, Handheld Blower).

- The quantities of each offered item.
