B. REQUEST FOR QUOTATION FOR A PREFERRED SUPPLIER FOR ELECTRICAL REPAIRS, MAINTENANCE AND INSTALLATION SERVICES, AND TESTING FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS

1. BACKGROUND TO SANSA

The South African National Space Agency (SANSA) has a mandate, as outlined in the South African National Space Agency Act, 2008 (Act No 36 of 2008), to co-ordinate and integrate national space science and technology programmes and conduct long-term planning and implementation of space-related activities in South Africa, for the benefit of the citizens of South Africa

2. SCOPE OF WORK (TERMS OF REFERENCE)

The South African National Space Agency SANSA is seeking a suitably qualified and experienced service provider to provide electrical repairs, maintenance and installation services and testing for the SANSA Hermanus campus. The campus is situated in the suburb of Westcliffe in Hermanus in the Western Cape province, and has numerous buildings utilised for office and laboratory space, accommodation, and instrumentation huts. The facility is a magnetically clean facility, and it is a 24-hour operation. Backup power is supplied to the site via a Generator.

The objective is to repair and maintain all electrical infrastructure on site. The services rendered must be done in a sustainable cost-effective manner whilst minimising downtime and ensuring safety, functionality, effectiveness, and compliance to legislations for all electrical installations.

An electrical contractor will be appointed to undertake repairs and maintenance of all electrical installations, testing, new installations, commissioning and decommissioning of electrical circuits which cover both the interior and exterior installations of buildings at SANSA Hermanus over a period of three (3) years on an as and when required basis. The successful bidder shall provide all necessary test equipment and labour to perform required inspection, testing, repairs and maintenance to affected electrical reticulation with minimal downtime.

The Bidder's team should include electricians with valid wiremens licences and be an approved electrical installer with proof of satisfactory service delivery.

The electrical services rendered will be on the SANSA Hermanus campus located in Westcliffe, Hermanus. Bidders MUST be 130KM radius of SANSA Hermanus.

The scope of work includes but is not limited to the below mentioned:

- Provision of Certificate of Compliance



- Installation, repairs and maintenance of:
 - Distributions boards
 - Day and night switches including timers
 - Earth leakage
 - Fans including extractor and other
 - Geyser Connections and terminations
 - Lighting Circuits
 - Load balancing
 - Luminaires
 - Plug circuits
 - Plug points
 - Poor earthing including earth spikes, earthing loops, earth lattice grids, earth plates
 - Cable joint repairs, Cable replacement and other
 - Thermographic inspections
 - Trunking including mounting, wiring, connections
 - Wiring faults such as loose connections, burnt wires
 - Wire ways
 - Star/Delta starters and motors



C. EVALUATION CRITERIA

SANSA promotes the concept of “best value” in the award of contracts, as opposed to merely looking for the cheapest price, which does not necessarily provide the best value. Best value incorporates the expertise, experience and technical proposal of the organisation and individuals who will be providing the service and the organisational capacity supporting the project team.

SANSA is committed to achieving Government's transformation objectives in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act.

The value of this bid is estimated not to exceed R1 million (all applicable taxes included) and therefore the **80/20** system shall be applicable.

Please Note: the above amount (R1 million) is not the budgeted amount for this project, but it is the Treasury threshold for written price quotations.

The procedure for the evaluation of responsive tenders is **price, functionality (quality) and preference** method. The evaluation of the bids will be conducted in the following two stages:

- Firstly, the assessment of quality will be done in terms of the evaluation criteria (Table 3) and the minimum threshold of 80 points explained below. A bid will be disqualified if it fails to meet the minimum threshold for functionality as per the bid invitation.
- Thereafter, only the qualifying bids are evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference points systems, where the 80 points will be used for price and the 20 points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the specific goals in accordance with the Table below.

1. Preference

Specific goals for this RFP and number of points are indicated as per table 1 below. Proof of the specific goals below must be attached and submitted with the bid document in order to qualify for the preference points (specific goals).
